



## 10. Safe Use of Chemicals

The Shed Members must avoid or minimise the exposure / use of harmful chemicals if possible.

Chemicals that are stored at the Shed need to be kept in accordance with the supplier's instructions.

The Shed will use glues, solvents, dyes, possibly bleaching agents such as oxalic acid and welding chemicals such as flux and boron. The list may grow as the Sheds activities widen in time.

All members who use these and other chemicals need to follow the applicable instructions.

All chemicals where possible, need to have the packaging / labelling prominently displayed on the container to ensure that the chance of confusion about the contents is minimised.

If a member has any doubts about a chemical, how to use it safely, store it or dispose of it, he should **seek advice prior to use**.

Shed members should be aware of the risks of use and how to clean up after use or spillage.
