



## 7. Waste Disposal

Waste must be disposed of correctly to ensure a safe environment and to comply with environmental requirements locally.

The Shed may generate:

- Food Waste
- Wood Waste
- Shavings and Dust
- Chemical Waste
- Paints and Toxic Waste

**Food Waste** – A bin is provided next to the kitchen for this, it is to be emptied regularly.

**Wood Waste** – There is a separate bin for this in the Workshop which this waste can be emptied into, or it can be taken away for burning on members' own log stove at their own risk.

**Shavings and Dust** – Bins are provided in the Workshop. These are to be emptied regularly.

**Chemical Waste** – Little is generated by the Shed. If required, the Household and Chemicals section at the local Milton recycling and disposal site can be used.

**Paint and Toxic Substances Waste** – Little is generated by the Shed. If required, the Household and Chemicals section at the local Milton recycling and disposal site can be used.

It is incumbent on all members to identify when bins need emptying; **it is not someone else's job.**
